# KEY INFORMATION REGARDING THE 2018 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS



## Who Can Vote?

A person is entitled to vote in a municipal election if he or she on voting day:

- Resides in the municipality or is the owner or tenant of land in the municipality or the spouse of such owner or tenant; and
- Is a Canadian citizen; and
- Is at least 18 years of age; and
- is not prohibited from voting under the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 or otherwise prohibited by law.

## Are You on the Voters' List?

The List of eligible voters for the upcoming municipal election is to be prepared by the Returning Officer/Clerk of your municipality. We all play a role in ensuring a fair electoral system, and it is the responsibility of every elector to make sure their information is up-to-date and accurately reflected for electoral purposes. Eligible Electors can log into [voterlookup.ca](http://voterlookup.ca) to:

- confirm or update their electoral information;
- add an elector name to an address;
- change school support;
