Dogs must remain under the care and control of their owner or tenant. Dogs should be confined to the property and leashed when walking on municipal roads.

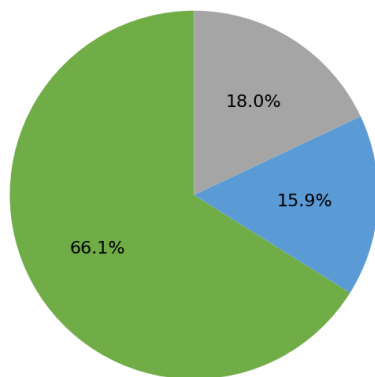
DRAINAGE REMINDER

2026 REVENUE - \$1,758,016

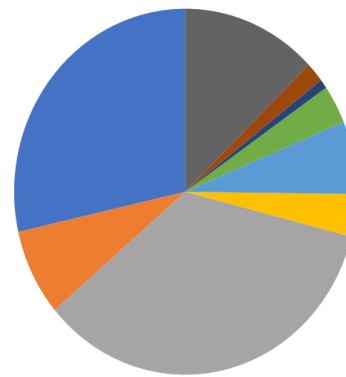

- **Harman's Road Bridge** – work continues to prepare the replacement project, so it is "shovel ready" for future funding opportunities.

THE TOWNSHIP OF EVANTUREL PASSED BY-LAW NO. 2026-23

A By-law prohibiting heavy truck traffic on portions of Bryan's Road and Wendigo Road to protect the road surface, reduce excessive wear, improve traffic safety, and address sightline and intersection concerns. "Bryan's Road Restricted Segment" means the portion of Bryan's Road from Wendigo Road to Highway 11. "Wendigo Road Restricted Segment" means the portion of Wendigo Road from Highway 624 to Bryan's Road. *Local deliveries, municipal operations, emergency services, and other approved access where appropriate will still be permitted.*

MUNICIPAL DRINKING WATER UPDATE

The Township continues to work with the Town of Englehart, the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks, legal counsel and other professionals regarding the following four non-municipal drinking water distribution systems:

- Brown's Road
- Bryan's Road
- First Street North
- Kap-Kig-Iwan Road

The Township's objective is to establish a compliant and dependable arrangement that protects residents connected to these systems. Additional information will be provided to affected property owners as it becomes available.

MUNICIPAL COMPLEX MEMORIAL GARDEN

The Memorial Garden is located at 414269 Bryan's Road. Trees and shrubs have been planted to create a peaceful space recognizing members of the community.
