RECYCLING DEPOT PROTOCOL

- A few totes will remain for deposit of cardboard – which must be broken down

Recycling Days – depending on the volume of recycling - collection may be later in the day – **leave your recycling at the curb – it may even be the next day.**

Waste Collection/Recycling Contracts 2025

Current 2024 Curbside Waste Collection/Recycling Contract will continue in 2025 - **unless you advise/have advised the Municipal Office, by December 31, 2024, you wish to cancel the contract.**

The 2025 Waste Collection/Recycling Calendar is enclosed with this newsletter.

Tenants – your landlord may purchase for you – if he/she does not want to purchase for you - the contract must be paid in advance.

Harman's Bridge Update

In 2022 the Bridge sustained severe damage due to a vehicular accident; and had to be closed. The bridge cannot be repaired and replacement is the only option.

Council has acquired the services of EXP Services Inc. to provide Consulting Engineering Services for the phased replacement of the Bridge. This phased replacement method will make the project "shovel ready" and eligible for any upcoming funding streams.

The flooding issues in April 2024 which washed out the culvert on Harman's Road, Municipality of Charlton and Dack, landlocked our residents located between the bridge and the washed-out site. Thank you again to the staff of the Municipality of Charlton and Dack for repairing the site, to its original set up, by the end of September 2024!

5. Emergency lighting/reflectors
6. First aid kit
7. Portable phone charger
8. Road maps
9. Booster cables or trickle charger
10. Ice scraper
11. Vehicle snow shovel
12. Sturdy tow rope
13. Granular ice melt
14. Emergency Radio

If you're using an artificial tree make sure you check the wires before you set it up and keep them covered so children and pets can't get to them.



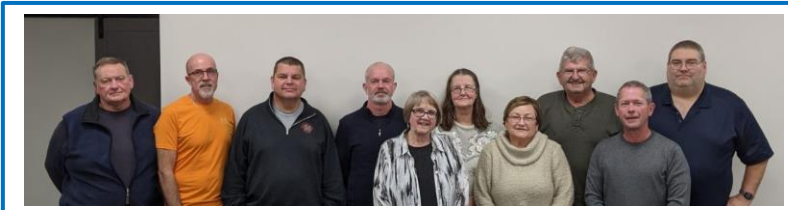
Englehart Nordic Ski Club Membership

Councillor Vacancy

The Township of Evanturel is seeking to fill one (1) vacant councillor position for the remainder of the 2022-2026 term of office. The vacant Councillor position will be by appointment by way of application; and as a result, no formal election or public vote will be conducted.

Council invites those interested in the position to file their names, including a brief resume, with the Clerk (or Deputy Clerk) no later than **Friday, January 3, 2025, at 4:00 p.m.** Applicants must be a qualified elector as defined in the *Municipal Elections Act* and must be:

1. A Canadian citizen;
2. At least 18 years old; resident of the Township of Evanturel; or the owner or tenant of land in the Township of Evanturel, or a spouse of such a person; and
3. Not prohibited from voting (as per the *Municipal Elections Act*) or otherwise by law
