New Waste Collection Policy 2026

The Township of Evanturel has created a Residential Curbside Waste Collection Policy effective January 1, 2026.

The rising cost of maintaining the Ingram Waste Disposal Site and continued improper deposit of waste at the site has prompted the Municipality to move to a mandatory program

All households, rental units and apartments will be required to participate in the new collection program.

Fee will be \$175.00 per unit/per year and added to the annual tax billing. Registered property owners with tenants will be responsible for these fees.

Recycling 2026

Collections – Fridays – see Calendar

The Province of Ontario is moving to a new recycling system – managed by Circular Materials.

The Township of Evanturel will move to this system January 1, 2026.

Residents who contracted Curbside Recycling in 2025 will continue to receive curbside recycling for the 2026 year. Carts will be delivered by GFL in the next few weeks.

Residents who DID NOT contract this service in 2025 will continue to deposit recycling at the Ingram Waste Disposal Site for the 2026 year.

Emergency Preparedness Pets

The Ontario SPCA recommends developing a family emergency response plan. This includes setting a primary and alternative meeting point away from the home in case of evacuation, listing emergency telephone numbers where all family members can find them (including the name and number of your pet's veterinarian) and putting together a family emergency survival kit, including a kit for your pets. Be sure to include your pet in any local or family emergency drills and exercises.

CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS ONTARIO

New Carbon Monoxide regulations will take effect January 1, 2026. The regulations require the installation of carbon monoxide alarms in all residential spaces with potential sources of gas. Some key points regarding detectors:

- Every home with a fuel-burning appliance, fireplace, or attached garage must have a carbon monoxide alarm next to each sleeping area and on every storey without a bedroom
- Testing – alarms must be tested monthly
- Homeowners – are responsible for owner-occupied homes
- Landlords – are responsible for rental properties
- Maintenance – alarms must be replaced every 7 to 10 years

A detector would make an excellent Christmas gift!!!

Excess Snow

By-law No. 362 – Prohibit the Obstruction and Encumbrance of Highways & Bridges

We would like to kindly remind everyone that depositing snow onto the road allowance is not an acceptable practice and prohibited by By-law 362. When snow is pushed onto the roadway, it creates unnecessary safety hazards for motorists, increases the risk of accidents, and can narrow the roadway.

Additionally our crews must spend extra time and resources clearing these deposits, which slows down overall winter maintenance operations.

We appreciate your cooperation in keeping our roads safe and our winter services efficient.
